

UNIVERSITY OF WOLLONGONG UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS' ASSOCIATION
REGULATIONS GOVERNING MEMBERS WHO RECEIVE AN ALLOWANCE

1. By virtue of Section 7, sub-section 7.1.1(c) of the Constitution of Wollongong Undergraduate Students' Association (WUSA), these Regulations shall be known as the Regulations Governing Members who Receive an Allowance from WUSA and all actions of such members shall be in accordance with the Constitution and Regulations of the Association

2. Interpretation

In addition to Section 1.2 of the Constitution the following terms shall have the meanings assigned thereto:

- 2.1 Allowance: monies paid by WUSA to a member subject to these Regulations.

- 2.2 Payment: method by which allowance is remunerated to member subject to these Regulations. The member to be paid by cheque in instalments. The number of instalments to be determined by each WUSA.

3. Determination, Eligibility and Amount(s)

- 3.1 Subject to Section 3.2 and 4 of these Regulations, no member shall receive an allowance unless a properly convened General Meeting of Students determines by motion.

- 3.2 Where members are acting as staff on activities, events and functions, they may receive a maximum allowance of 5 hours in accordance with casual rates.

- 3.3 The amount of the President's and Media Officer's allowance shall be \$11,000.00 p.a. for the calendar year of 1991, indexed to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for every subsequent year.

- 3.4 Excluding the President and the Media Officer an officer should not be paid for anything that would otherwise be required of them according to their officer responsibilities.

4. The following members shall receive an allowance subject to these Regulations:

- 4.1 The President.

4.2 The Media Officer.

5. Any allowance payable to a member subject to these Regulations shall be separate from any banking account or accounts as described in the Constitution, Section 8.
- 6.1 The proportion of the annual allowance received by a WUSA member at any given date shall not exceed the proportion of the year that has elapsed since the beginning of his/her term of office.
- 6.2 The payment of an allowance to members shall be stopped where they are being removed from office in accordance with sections 4.4 of the Constitution
7. Where the Regulations appear to be inconsistent with the Constitution, the Constitution shall be the authoritative source and that section of the Regulations which is inconsistent with the Constitution shall be null and void.
