Why does WUSA collect personal information?

What does WUSA do with the information?

WUSA will not provide your personal information to any other organisation except where necessary eg to verify your enrolment with the University of Wollongong.

We won't sell, trade or exchange your information without your permission.

When you send an email through the site, such as to the University of Wollongong administration, a newspaper or member of Parliament, the email will include your email address and full name. When you sign a petition, we will publish your name, town and state, but not your email or physical address.

We'll make all reasonable efforts to store your information safely and securely.
